Pastor's Corner:

Promise Fulfilled! (Acts 2:1-4, NIV)

"When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them."

Next to Easter, no other day is more important in Christendom than the Day of Pentecost. Pentecost is the celebration of the birth of the Church when the promised Holy Spirit descended on the devoted disciples gathered in obedience in Jerusalem.

Prophet Joel prophesied the event that occurred at Pentecost – the outpouring of the Spirit of God on the gathered disciples hundreds of years long before it occurred. Joel had called the people of Judah to repentance warning them to turn from their sins to God. Even as God promised to punish them for their sins, He also promised to show them mercy by looking favorably on them and to pour out His Spirit upon all people: *"In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on servants – men and women alike."* (**Joel 2:29**)

Prior to the event that occurred at Pentecost, the Spirit of God was only given to selected people to empower them to carry out specific crucial tasks. Before His crucifixion, Jesus assured the disciples that He was not going to leave them without the crucial resource to carry out the task He had given to them. Jesus told them and He tells us: *"If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and he will; give you another Counselor to be with you forever – the Spirit of truth."* (**John 14:15-17**)

The Spirit of truth did not only empower the disciples, but the Spirit also enabled them to continue the ministry of Jesus by teaching and revealing to them how to please God as they made disciples of others. The disciples had learnt many things from Jesus and in obedience to His clear instruction in **Acts 1:4-5** did not leave Jerusalem but waited for the gift the Father promised. Jesus underscored for them and for us the importance of this gift in **Acts 1:8**: *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

Jesus was crucified at Passover time, and He ascended 40 days after His Resurrection. Pentecost happened 10 days after the ascension of Jesus. God did not want this singular event that birthed the Church to be missed. The Holy Spirit descended on the disciples like tongues of fire, which symbolize speech, and the proclamation of the Good News. The fire also symbolized God's purifying presence that burns away the undesirable elements of our lives and sets our hearts aflame to ignite the lives of others. **GOD DELIVERED ON HIS PROMISE.**

One of the gifts of our Baptism is the Holy Spirit which God gives to us as our identifier. When you meet serious or die-hard fans of any sport, it is easy to identify them because they usually have memorabilia that associates them with their favorite team or sports. Paul's letter to the Ephesians reminds us of the role of the Spirit in our lives: *"Having believed, you were marked with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a DEPOSIT guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession."* (**Ephesians 1:13-14**)

When we baptize new believers in the name of the triune God – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit as Jesus Christ commanded, we believe without a doubt that the Holy Spirit descends on the person and in-dwells them. However, the gifts of the Spirit sometimes need to be fanned into flame, so they are readily evident in our lives. As we celebrate Pentecost today, it is a wonderful opportunity for us to ask God to fill us afresh with His Holy Spirit. **GOD FULFILLED HIS PROMISE** by sending down the Spirit on all believers almost two thousand years ago. Are you spiritually hungry? God is always more ready to answer than we can ask. May the Spirit divine fill us all to overflowing today and always so we can continually witness to Jesus the Risen Christ who is to come.

The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

2 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues^[a] as the Spirit enabled them.

⁵ Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. ⁶ When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken. ⁷ Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans?" ⁸ Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language? ⁹ Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia,^[b] ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome ¹¹ (both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" ¹² Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"

¹³ Some, however, made fun of them and said, "They have had too much wine."

Peter Addresses the Crowd

¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. ¹⁵ These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! ¹⁶ No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:

¹⁷ "'In the last days, God says,
