

# MESSAGE NOTES – Third Sunday in Lent (3/23/2025) Christian To The Core – Week # 12: Living Christian To The Core – God Is At Work In You (Philippians 2:12-18 & Matthew 7:21-27)

"Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed — not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence — continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose." (Philippians 2:12-13, NIV)

An Amazing Truth: Living Christian to the Core is an adventure in the Kingdom of God, and this twelve-session journey is a beginning point to live the rest of our lives. The values are rooted in an amazing truth:

God sent Jesus to die for our sin so we might have access to the power of God by His Spirit to live for His glory.

Jesus underscores the importance of our mission in **Matthew 10:8**: "Freely you have received; freely give."

We began this series with a powerful statement from the prophet Habakkuk, "Look at the nations and watch — and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told." (Habakkuk 1:5)

#### BIBLICAL FOUNDATION - IT IS GOD WHO WORKS IN YOU.

God is at work in us and through us. That is the conviction we share. This is God's plan. The Christian To The Core Curriculum has given us the basics of devoted discipleship.

**Expectations Fulfilled:** At the beginning of this series back in January, we were asked to identify our expectations for this journey. For those who have stayed on track, they can go back to their curriculum and review how they answered the following questions on pages 13-14:

I want to learn more about ..........
I want to learn how to ........
I want my spiritual life to be different by .......

The Eight Core Values Revisited: It would be helpful to ask ourselves as we reflect together: "What Have You Discovered?"

**Intimacy with God** is an eternal journey.

**Passion for the Harvest** is the eternal flame that touches our hearts and fills us with love and purpose.

A Visionary Life is a lifestyle of purpose that is uniquely crafted around our gifts and the needs of others.

**Culturally Relevant Evangelism** is sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. **Multiplication of Discipleship** invites spiritual fruitfulness as God uses us to implant the very life of Christ in the hearts of others.

**Family Priority** declares that family is the building block of all relationships and our first place of influence.

**Faithful Stewardship** actualizes the blessings of Christ's Lordship over our lives and all creation.

Integrity is life lived according to design.

**Reflection Questions:** Of the Eight Core Values, which one has impacted your life the greatest since this journey began? Why? Of the Eight Core Values, which do you feel need to be strengthened the most in your life?

Whether we know it or not, we are all different now. "How great is the love of the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called the children of God! And that is what we are! The reason that the world does not know us is that it did not know Him. Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when He appears, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is." (1 John 3:1-2)

Apostle Paul echoes this expectation: "Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into His likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." (2 Corinthians 3:17–18)

As we purposefully live the Eight Core Values, we become Christian to the Core. Paul instruction to Timothy will be helpful: "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others." (2 Timothy 2:2)

Who will you invite alongside you on the journey? God is looking for men and women who will invest the Eight Core Values in another person's life. If we invest in another person, then our life will never be the same.
